### Schematics and Facility Identification

Accurate schematics are essential for understanding facility processes and measurement points. Production Accountants need to be equipped with accurate schematics for their wells and facilities to avoid costly errors by creating verifiable production accounting formulas and processes. Learn to interpret these diagrams and ensure they are reflected in the monthly PA process with this seminar, provided by CAPPA and Mount Royal University.

Part 1 (morning) discusses schematics from a Production Accounting perspective. Topics include:

- common symbols
- information schematics should contain
- examples of schematics for different types of facilities
- discussions of strategies for updating schematics, document management and PA responsibilities
- group exercises to help you apply concepts

Part 2 (afternoon) focuses on segregating facilities for accounting purposes. With many facilities physically connected together, it can be a challenge to determine where one facility ends and the next begins. Topics include:

- review of ERCB Facility Subtypes
- measurement requirement
- group facility delineation exercise
